Location

The Belmore Court & Motel is located on the edge of Enniskillen, opposite Tesco, on the corner of Dublin Road (A4) and Tempo Road (B80).

From **Belfast** (80 miles) take the M1 motorway west for 35 miles to Dungannon, leading on to the A4 Ballygawley Road. At the Ballygawley Roundabout take the first exit and go straight through Augher, Clogher and Fivemiletown. As you come into Enniskillen turn right at the first set of traffic lights and the Motel is immediately on your left.

From **Dublin** (100 miles) follow the signposts for Cavan (N3). Travel through Navan, Kells, Virginia, Belturbet and Derrylin to Enniskillen. Pick up signs for Belfast and make your way through the town and you will see the Motel on the left opposite the Tesco Supermarket.

There is complimentary car parking onsite at the Belmore Court & Motel

Bus



From **Belfast** use the Ulsterbus Goldline Service 261 from Europa Buscentre which currently operate about once per hour from 8.05am until 8.05pm Monday to Friday. The journey is approximately 2 hours and 15 minutes. On Saturday the service starts at 10.05 pm and runs almost every hour until 8.05pm. On Sunday there are five buses running at regular intervals between 12:45pm and 8.05pm.

The return trip from Enniskillen to Belfast also runs hourly from Monday to Friday - 6.20am until 6.25pm. Saturday runs start at 7.25pm with 8 buses travelling until 6.25pm. Sunday offer seven buses starting at 9.25am until 6.25pm.

From **Belfast City Airport (George Best Airport)**

Use the Metro Service 600 from the City Airport into the Europa Buscentre then follow the details from Belfast by bus above. Usually every 20 minutes.

From **Dublin** use the Bus Eireann no.30 from Busáras (Central Bus Station) which operates Monday to Saturday up to nine times per day from 7.00am until Midnight. The journey takes about 3 hours and 10 minutes. On Sundays bus times are similar to weekdays.
